

CHAIR BLACK STAINED BEECH CURULE

Technical characteristics

Reproduction of a chair designed by Pierre Paulin at the beginning of the Eighties, which was displayed at the musée des Arts décoratifs in September 1983. **CONSTRUCTION** Curved solid beech slats, cut from the same piece of wood and assembled using threaded steel posts and rivets. **COMFORT** Seat and arms in beech. Backrest in soft pigmented full grain hide. Seat folds in the centre. **MAKING-UP** Frame in matt varnished black-stained beech with backrest in black hide. The name Pierre Paulin is stamped on every Curule chair, on the lower rear part of the frame.
